- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Herbert Campbell; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Herbert Campbell on February 23, 2024; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Herbert Campbell served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with
5 the United States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during
6 World War II and earning three Bronze Stars; and
- 7 WHEREAS, after his honorary discharge from service, he utilized the engineering expertise
8 and knowledge he gained to found Campbell's Erosion Control as well as to work for the Sea
9 Island Company on the Golden Isles; and
- 10 WHEREAS, fondly known as Papa or Herbie to his family and friends, he was cherished for
11 his kindness, his care for the community, and his love for the animals that frequently visited
12 him for pets and treats; and

13 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
14 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
15 family and friends were admired by others; and

16 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
17 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
18 made this world a better place in which to live; and

19 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Herbert Campbell will long be remembered
20 for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great
21 fortune of knowing him.
