A RESOLUTION

- 1 Encouraging the Department of Community Health to create and seek the counsel of a State
- 2 Health Benefit Plan Customer Advisory Council; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Department of Community Health would benefit from creating an advisory
- 4 panel composed of customers of the state health benefit plan to advise the commissioner of
- 5 community health on components, provisions, elements, strategies, marketing, and customer
- 6 satisfaction of the state health benefit plan; and
- 7 WHEREAS, such State Health Benefit Plan Customer Advisory Council should be composed
- 8 of 12 uncompensated members, all of whom are participants in the state health benefit plan
- 9 and each of whom is an active or retired member of the Employees' Retirement System of
- 10 Georgia or the Teachers Retirement System of Georgia; and
- WHEREAS, at least three members should be retired members of the Teachers Retirement
- 12 System of Georgia, and at least two members should be retired members of the Employees'
- 13 Retirement System of Georgia; and
- 14 WHEREAS, each member of the council should be appointed by the commissioner from
- 15 nominations provided by nonprofit associations and the human resource units of each state
- department which represents at least 1,000 members of the state health benefit plan; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the commissioner should meet with the council to solicit input and consult with
- its members in the development of changes to the state health benefit plan prior to approval
- 19 of any such changes by the Board of Community Health; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the commissioner should present implementation strategies and logistics to such
- 21 council for advice prior to the adoption and implementation of such strategies and logistics;
- 22 and

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WHEREAS, the commissioner should solicit councilmembers' organizations in informing

- 24 and educating active and retired state health benefit plan participants of changes in such plans
- or other issues prior to the adoption of such changes by the board; and
- 26 WHEREAS, the commissioner should provide the council with all departmental state health
- 27 benefit plan recommendations to be made to the board and should provide the council
- 28 chairperson the opportunity on behalf of the council to make comments to the board prior to
- 29 the board taking action on such recommendations.
- 30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 31 the members of this body encourage the Department of Community Health to create and seek
- 32 the counsel of a State Health Benefit Plan Customer Advisory Council.
- 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 34 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 35 Governor Nathan Deal and Commissioner Clyde L. Reese III of the Department of
- 36 Community Health.
