A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the volunteers of the Civil Air Patrol for their service to the citizens of Georgia
- 2 and recognizing March 21, 2018, as Civil Air Patrol Day at the state capitol; and for other
- 3 purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol was founded on December 1, 1941, as an organization of
- 5 volunteers to assist the United States military in national defense by performing aerial coastal
- 6 patrols and emergency services within the continental United States; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in 1943, the capabilities of this new volunteer organization were recognized as
- 8 vital to this country's national defense, and by Presidential Executive Order, the Civil Air
- 9 Patrol was assigned to the War Department and was subsequently chartered by Congress to
- 10 perform three distinct missions: emergency services, aerospace education, and cadet
- 11 programs; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol air and ground teams perform over 90 percent of inland
- 13 search and rescue missions tasked by the Air Force Rescue Coordination Center; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the Georgia Wing of the Civil Air Patrol consists of over 1,900 volunteer
- 15 members in 45 squadrons and four groups located throughout this state; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Georgia Wing squadrons have been awarded the National Squadron of
- 17 Distinction in 2008 and 2009, the Southeast Region Squadron of Distinction in 2010, and
- 18 numerous other awards for counter drug, emergency services, and cadet programs; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Georgia Wing members are an intricate component of this country's national
- 20 defense who volunteer their services, time, and resources to actively support the Civil Air
- 21 Patrol by conducting missions in homeland security, disaster relief emergency services,
- search and rescue, counter drug, aerospace education, and cadet programs; and

23 WHEREAS, their contributions to this state are constantly evidenced through their efforts

- 24 to locate missing aircrafts and people in Georgia, to locate and silence numerous activated
- 25 distress beacons, to conduct "Sundown Patrols" in South Georgia, and to conduct joint
- 26 exercises with local emergency agencies throughout this state; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Georgia Wing volunteers also supported the Governor's Task Force for Drug
- 28 Suppression and other antidrug efforts, honored more than 15,000 of Georgia's fallen soldiers
- 29 through the Wreaths Across America initiative, and introduced hundreds of Georgia youth
- 30 to aviation through the flight orientation programs; and
- 31 WHEREAS, the estimated value of the Georgia Wing members' volunteer hours is almost
- 32 immeasurable; and
- 33 WHEREAS, these "flying minutemen" of the Civil Air Patrol have, since the program's
- 34 inception, consistently provided this state with invaluable emergency services, aerospace
- 35 education, and cadet programs.
- 36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 37 the members of this body commend the volunteers of the Civil Air Patrol for their service to
- 38 the citizens of Georgia and recognize March 21, 2018, as Civil Air Patrol Day at the state
- 39 capitol.
- 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 41 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 42 Georgia Wing of the Civil Air Patrol.
