A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Community Organized Relief Effort; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Community Organized Relief Effort (CORE) is a crisis response organization
3 that brings immediate aid and recovery to underserved communities across the globe; and
- 4 WHEREAS, this remarkable organization impacts Georgia's communities by increasing and
5 diversifying access to COVID-19, flu, and monkeypox resources and health equity focused
6 vaccination services supported by communications and health outreach teams; and
- 7 WHEREAS, CORE has administered more than 400,000 COVID-19 tests and 600,000
8 COVID-19 vaccines at up to 15 Georgia health districts since April 2020; and
- 9 WHEREAS, CORE has held over 25 events weekly in collaboration with more than 1,000
10 different site partners for vaccination events; over 1,900 community vaccination events in
11 more than 100 Georgia counties; and over 70 monkeypox events; and
- 12 WHEREAS, CORE mobilizes more than 75 staff members, including 13 health outreach
13 coordinators, to provide COVID-19 relief and health equity services as well as to assist
14 individuals in accessing benefit programs; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this distinguished organization be
16 appropriately honored.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body recognize and commend Community Organized Relief Effort for
19 its many exemplary contributions on behalf of the citizens of this state and beyond as well
20 as extend best wishes for continued success.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
22 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to
23 Community Organized Relief Effort.
