

## House Resolution 1407

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending CORE (Community Organized Relief Effort); and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, CORE (Community Organized Relief Effort) is a crisis response organization  
4 that brings immediate aid and recovery to under served communities across the globe; and

5 WHEREAS, CORE impacts Georgia communities by increasing and diversifying access to  
6 COVID-19, Flu, and Mpox resources; and

7 WHEREAS, CORE's health equity focused vaccination services are supported by  
8 communications and health outreach teams; and

9 WHEREAS, CORE has administered more than 400,000 COVID-19 tests and more than  
10 600,000 COVID-19 vaccines including more than 141,000 at mobile vaccination sites in up  
11 to 15 Georgia health districts since April 2020; and

12 WHEREAS, CORE has also provided more than 6,700 gift cards at more than 800  
13 incentivized events in 2023; and

14 WHEREAS, CORE has held over 25 events weekly in collaboration with more than 1,000  
15 different site partners for vaccination events, over 1,900 community vaccination events in  
16 more than 100 Georgia counties, and more than 70 Mpox events; and

17 WHEREAS, CORE has distributed more than 1,500 units of Narcan and more than 1,800  
18 HIV/STI tests; and

19 WHEREAS, CORE mobilizes more than 75 staff including 13 health outreach coordinators  
20 to provide COVID-19 relief and health equity services and facilitate more than 600  
21 applicants for benefits programs with more than 200 referrals to community-based  
22 organizations; and

23 WHEREAS, CORE is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments  
24 of this remarkable and distinguished organization be appropriately recognized.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
26 the members of this body recognize and commend CORE and thank it for its efforts of  
27 behalf of its community and state.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
29 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to  
30 CORE.
