### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Mr. C. Max Toles and dedicating an intersection in his memory; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. C. Max Toles was a successful businessperson with a renowned career in  
4 real estate sales and development; and

5 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United  
6 States Air Force, valiantly defending America during the Korean War; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Toles joined Adrian Howell & Covington as the firm's sales manager in  
8 1966 and later became a part owner of the brokerage, which was then renamed  
9 Covington & Toles; and

10 WHEREAS, years later Mr. Toles established Toles, Temple & Wright, Inc., and he was  
11 instrumental in spurring the development of subdivisions and other housing options  
12 throughout Rome, Georgia, positively impacting the growth of the community; and

13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
14 Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an intersection in his memory.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
16 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of U.S. Route 27/Turner McCall Boulevard  
17 and Avenue A in Floyd County is dedicated as the C. Max Toles Intersection.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
19 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the C. Max Toles Intersection.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
21 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
22 family of Mr. C. Max Toles and to the Department of Transportation.
