3 community in the death of Patricia Annette Lowery; and

5 working tirelessly with Action-Gwinnett County to educate the community, improve voter
6 participation, support the rights of women, and build community activism; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Patricia Annette Lowery worked diligently on political campaigns to promote
8 justice, equity, and safety for all members of the community; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the international community benefitted from her service as a delegation member
10 to Germany in support of human rights in South Africa in the 1960s; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Patricia Annette Lowery was a dedicated care giver to her brother, a loving and
12 supportive mother and grandmother, and a committed friend to all who knew her; and

13 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
14 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
15 her family and friends were admired by others; and

16 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
17 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,
18 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

19 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Patricia Annette Lowery will long be
20 remembered for her love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who
21 had the great fortune of knowing her.
