- 2 WHEREAS, Jessica Wilson was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis in her early twenties,
- 3 leaving her disabled for life. Her mission became to promote positivity and spread kindness
- 4 in the community for as long as her life allowed and in any way she could; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Jessica is a beacon of hope within the Buford community. She decided to
- 6 dedicate her time to making a difference within her community. Throughout her life, she has
- 7 accomplished just that by spreading positivity in the lives of those she meets; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Jessica advocates for those who are voiceless. She started the North Gwinnett
- 9 Voice, a local newspaper, and has filled its pages with stories of good deeds and free
- 10 promotion and publicity for nonprofits, many of which are now household names; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Jessica provides the youth in Buford and Sugar Hill the opportunity to write for
- 12 the North Gwinnett Voice and the opportunity to earn scholarship money for college to

14 WHEREAS, Jessica has volunteered at local domestic abuse shelters by providing

- 15 self-defense classes, opportunities to learn professional skills, clothing, and direction for
- 16 independence; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Jessica has provided vehicles and housing to young homeless mothers, helping
- 18 them find placement while they transitioned to permanent housing; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Jessica has motivated dozens of individuals to enter rehabilitation programs,
- 20 resulting in many overcoming their addictions to drugs and alcohol. Through years of
- 21 volunteering at local rehabilitation centers, she offered transportation, assisted in
- 22 employment, and helped those struggling with addiction create healthier connections within
- 23 their community; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Jessica is a state-approved licensed foster parent in the community, Foster Care
- 25 Piedmont. Jessica also volunteers in her local District 9 community, teaching Sunday school
- 26 to children, reminding them that they are never alone or forgotten; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Jessica has been involved in many outreach programs for our local homeless,
- 28 providing resources, transportation, food, and shelter placement; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Jessica is a strong supporter of community and collaboration. She invests time
- 30 and resources in other small businesses or entrepreneurs alike, supporting them however they
- 31 need help, including through charitable outreach, community events, or networking and
- 32 mentoring when needed; and
- 33 WHEREAS, Jessica promotes positivity in the press and in everyday life with all whose
- 34 paths she might cross on her journey of life; and

- 36 providing only the facts without leading or misrepresenting them to conform to a particular
- 37 idea or destined outcome for the benefit of others, allowing her readers to interpret the
- 38 information on their own; and
- 39 WHEREAS, Jessica has participated in many local organizations, including the mentorship
- 40 of young aspiring writers/journalists through the community high schools and colleges,
- 41 providing mentorship and opportunities for young writers to build strong ethical foundations
- 42 and guidance to assist with their career aspirations. She uses her connections and reputation
- 43 to help them start their careers with other strong leaders in the writing community who can
- 44 continue to build the next generation of writers; and
- 45 WHEREAS, Jessica monetarily contributes to the North Gwinnett Co-op and other food
- 46 banks, student fund-raisers, scholarships, and local nonprofits in the Buford and Sugar Hill
- 47 area.
