1 Recognizing and commending Francine Moore on her outstanding public service; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the eldest of six children, Francine Moore was born to Frank and Frankie
4 McDowell at Atlanta's Grady Hospital on June 16, 1950; and

5 WHEREAS, growing up in Atlanta, she attended Atlanta Public Schools throughout her
6 childhood, ultimately graduating from Price High School in 1968; and

7 WHEREAS, an excellent student at Price, Francine earned a scholarship to attend Grady
8 Nursing School, and she became the first member of her family to go to college; and

9 WHEREAS, of approximately 110 nursing students to start the program in 1968, Francine
10 was one of 66 to complete the rigorous curriculum and graduate as part of the Grady Nursing
11 School Class of 1971, one of the first integrated classes in the school's history; and

12 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
13 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

14 WHEREAS, she has since spent her entire career as a psychiatric nurse at Grady, and June
15 2021 will mark her 50th year of dedicated service to Grady Hospital and the Atlanta,
16 Georgia, community; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
18 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body recognize and commend Francine Moore for her 50 years of
21 outstanding service to Grady Hospital and extend sincere best wishes for many more years
22 of health and happiness.
