A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Homestead Exemptions Impacting City of Atlanta
- 2 Residents; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, homesteaded residents of the City of Atlanta have many homestead exemptions
- 4 from ad valorem taxation for real property available between the taxing jurisdictions of
- 5 Fulton County, DeKalb County, the Atlanta Independent School District, and the City of
- 6 Atlanta; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the homestead exemptions currently provided are difficult to understand and
- 8 often create confusion for taxpayers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, homesteaded property owners in the City of Atlanta should be afforded clarity
- 10 in the various homestead exemptions available and should have a more equitable schedule
- 11 of exemptions; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Georgia law does not currently provide clarity on the various homestead
- 13 exemptions; and
- 14 WHEREAS, thoughtful consideration should be given to the role that Fulton County, DeKalb
- 15 County, the Atlanta Independent School District, and the City of Atlanta should play in
- 16 informing Atlanta's residents of homestead exemptions; and
- 17 WHEREAS, creating a simpler, more understandable method of determining the various
- 18 homestead exemptions and a more equitable method of gaining exemptions should be
- 19 studied.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- 21 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
- on Homestead Exemptions Impacting City of Atlanta Residents.

23 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the

- 24 City of Atlanta delegation of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker
- of the House of Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee
- as chairperson of the committee.
- 27 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 30 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- 31 shall hold at least five meetings and may conduct such meetings at such places and at
- 32 such times as it may deem necessary or convenient to enable it to exercise fully and
- effectively its powers, perform its duties, and accomplish the objectives and purposes of
- 34 this resolution.

(5) Allowances and funding.

- 36 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided
- for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- 38 (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member
- of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds
- 40 necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.

42 (6) **Report.**

- 43 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 47 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- 49 of this paragraph.
- 50 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- 53 the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
- House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
- 56 thereof.
- 57 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2016.
