## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending CHRIS Kids for its 35 year commitment and leadership in
- 2 Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, CHRIS Kids promotes trauma informed best practices in Georgia and is
- 4 committed to helping children, young adults, and families with behavioral health challenges
- 5 assume responsibility for their lives, develop the skills they need to navigate life's challenges,
- 6 and build natural support systems so that they can become contributing members of our local
- 7 communities; and
- 8 WHEREAS, CHRIS Kids was founded by the Junior League of Atlanta in 1981 to fill a gap
- 9 in services for children with severe mental health needs in foster care who did not need to
- 10 be institutionalized and who could remain in the community if provided adequate behavioral
- 11 health services and support; and
- 12 WHEREAS, CHRIS Kids opened the first program in Georgia in 1986 to serve youth aging
- out of foster care and they opened the first program in Georgia to serve homeless youth in
- 14 2000; and
- 15 WHEREAS, today, CHRIS Kids offers an array of highly effective, trauma informed
- 16 counseling, support services, and housing that are innovative, inclusive, and individualized
- 17 through its various programs; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the CHRIS Counseling Center provides school based mental health services for
- 19 children and their families in more than 20 schools in the metro public and charter school
- 20 systems; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the CHRIS Counseling Center employs more than 36 percent of the certified
- trauma therapists in the State of Georgia and utilizes more than 18 different evidenced based

24 WHEREAS, CHRIS Kids services to children and families result in 100 percent of children

- 25 being kept safe from harm, 90 percent of families strengthened, and 78 percent of designated
- 26 juvenile felonies did not re-offend and successfully completed probation over the past two
- 27 years; and
- 28 WHEREAS, through the CHRIS Training Institute, CHRIS Kids provides training to other
- 29 nonprofits, the community, and state personnel in best clinical practices, trauma informed
- 30 care, child sexual abuse prevention, and anti-bullying to expand the scope of healing in the
- 31 community; and
- 32 WHEREAS, CHRIS Kids is an innovator, convener, and collaborator seeking to avoid
- 33 duplication and leverage its core competencies in partnership with others; and
- 34 WHEREAS, former clients living across the United States include servicemen and
- 35 servicewomen, IT professionals, entrepreneurs, actors, musicians, and employees in all
- 36 aspects of the business community; and
- 37 WHEREAS, CHRIS Kids proves year after year that when children, young adults, and
- 38 families are provided services, support, acceptance, and accountability, they can succeed in
- 39 becoming productive citizens who can, and do, end cycles of intergenerational abuse,
- 40 neglect, and failure in their lives.
- 41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 42 the members of this body recognize and commend CHRIS Kids for its 35 year commitment
- 43 and leadership in Georgia in helping more than 50,000 people with behavioral health
- 44 challenges develop the resiliency skills they need to navigate life's challenges and become
- 45 contributing members of our local communities.
