A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing August 2020 as National Minority Donor Awareness Month; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, one of the most meaningful gifts that a human being can bestow upon another
- 4 is the gift of life; and
- 5 WHEREAS, more than 112,000 men, women, and children, 4,800 of whom reside in
- 6 Georgia, await life-saving or life-enhancing organ transplants; and
- 7 WHEREAS, more than 71 percent of those awaiting a transplant in Georgia are ethnic
- 8 minorities; and
- 9 WHEREAS, African Americans make up the largest group of minorities in need of an organ
- 10 transplant; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the need for organ, eye, and tissue donation grows daily, with a new patient
- being added to the national waiting list for an organ transplant every ten minutes; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the critical donor shortage remains a public health crisis; and owing to the lack
- of available organs, an average of 22 people on the waiting list die each day; and
- 15 WHEREAS, organ, eye, and tissue donations can provide grieving families the comfort of
- 16 knowing that their gift endows another person with renewed hope for a healthy life; and
- 17 WHEREAS, donating life through organ, eye, and tissue donation is the ultimate act of
- 18 generosity and kindness that we, as Georgians, can perform; and
- 19 WHEREAS, more than 4.9 million Georgians have already registered their decision to give
- 20 the gift of life at www.DonateLifeGeorgia.org, when getting or renewing their driver's

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21 license or state identification card at a driver's license office, or when purchasing a hunting

- 22 or fishing license through the Georgia Department of Natural Resources; and
- 23 WHEREAS, in order to increase the number of lives saved through organ transplantation,
- 24 LifeLink of Georgia, the nonprofit community service organization dedicated to the recovery
- of high quality organs and tissues for transplantation, provides public education to minority
- 26 communities throughout Georgia all year and, particularly, during the month of August in
- 27 celebration of National Minority Donor Awareness Month; and

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- 29 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia supports the life-saving mission of LifeLink of Georgia.
- 30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 31 the members of this body recognize August 2020 as National Minority Donor Awareness
- 32 Month.
- 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 34 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 35 public and the press.
