A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Crime Victims' Rights; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Federal Bureau of Investigation records over 35,000 cases of murder, rape,
- 3 robbery, and assault in Georgia each year; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Georgia is one of only 18 states that does not guarantee rights to victims of
- 5 violent crime in their state constitutions; and
- 6 WHEREAS, in 2004, the United States Congress adopted the Crime Victims' Rights Act, 18
- 7 U.S.C. Section 3771, providing crime victims standing to assert their rights directly; and
- 8 WHEREAS, currently in Georgia, the accused and convicted perpetrators of violent crime
- 9 are afforded numerous state constitutional rights in the criminal justice system; and
- 10 WHEREAS, state constitutions address a wide array of issues deemed by the states to be of
- sufficient importance to be included in the constitution rather than in ordinary statutes; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Georgia's Crime Victims' Bill of Rights, Code Section 17-17-1, et seq., does not
- 13 provide a crime victim standing to enforce their rights; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Georgia should affirm that crime victims' rights, while different from those of
- 15 the accused or convicted perpetrator, are not less important; and
- 16 WHEREAS, efforts need to be undertaken to protect crime victims and ensure that their
- welfare, healing, and needs are considered at each phase in the criminal justice process; and
- 18 WHEREAS, these efforts should establish enforceable constitutional rights for victims of
- 19 crime in a way that would be consistent with and not undermine rights that currently exist
- 20 in statute.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

- 22 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
- on Crime Victims' Rights.
- 24 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of three members of the
- 25 House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 26 Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson
- of the committee.
- 28 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 31 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

35 (5) Allowances and funding.

- 36 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided
- for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- 38 (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member
- of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds
- 40 necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.

42 (6) **Report.**

- 43 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 47 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- 49 of this paragraph.
- 50 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
- House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
- 56 thereof.
- 57 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2016.
