A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the Elbert County United States Army Junior Reserve Officers' Training
2 Corps Program Female Armed Squad for its 2023 State Championship; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the Elbert County United States Army Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps
5 Program Female Armed Squad has a long tradition of competitive excellence; and

6 WHEREAS, in 2022, the Female Armed Squad tied for first place at the state competition,
7 but lost the tie breaker; and

8 WHEREAS, the 2023 season presented the squad with some personnel changes, but the
9 squad remained committed and worked tirelessly to return to the state competition and bring
10 home a first-place trophy; and

11 WHEREAS, the 2023 season presented formidable challenges to the squad, starting with the
12 first competition of the season when temperatures were below freezing, and the difficulties
13 and challenges continued throughout the season; and

14 WHEREAS, the squad did not achieve a first place finish until the final meet of the season
15 at Cedar Shoals for state qualifiers, but the squad persevered and, through much hard work,

29 Daniel Ulrich guided and encouraged the squad along the way; and
