## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the importance of ensuring access to higher education for all Georgians; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, access to education is a fundamental human right; and
- 4 WHEREAS, according to a report by the Migration Policy Institute, 54,000 undocumented
- 5 students between the ages of 16 and 24 call Georgia home; and
- 6 WHEREAS, undocumented immigrants living in Georgia paid an estimated \$355.2 million
- 7 in state and local taxes in 2018; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the University System of Georgia Board of Regents policy 4.1.6 bars
- 9 undocumented students from enrolling at the University of Georgia, Georgia Institute of
- 10 Technology, and Georgia State University, among other institutions, regardless of academic
- 11 qualifications; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Georgia is one of only three states in the country to ban undocumented students
- 13 from attending certain public postsecondary educational institutions; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Georgia ranks in the bottom third of states for adults with an associate's degree
- 15 or higher; and
- 16 WHEREAS, an educated populace benefits all Georgia residents; and
- 17 WHEREAS, it is in the best economic interest of the State of Georgia to remove barriers to
- 18 education, such as permitting undocumented students to be admitted to state institutions of
- 19 higher learning; and

20 WHEREAS, equal opportunity and education are quintessential American and Georgian

- 21 values.
- 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 23 the members of this body encourage the Board of Regents of the University System of
- 24 Georgia to repeal rule 4.1.6 and allow Georgians of all backgrounds, regardless of
- 25 immigration status, to enroll in any University System of Georgia institution.
- 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of this body recognize the importance of
- 27 ensuring access to higher education for all Georgians.
- 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 29 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 30 public and the press.
