A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of SPC Jackie Marcell Morgan and dedicating a bridge in his memory; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put
4 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the
5 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and

6 WHEREAS, SPC Jackie Marcell Morgan was born on March 6, 1941, and served as a
7 guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United States Armed Forces during the
8 Vietnam War; and

9 WHEREAS, he demonstrated a deep personal commitment to protecting democracy and a
10 willingness to sacrifice his own personal safety and comfort to ensure the well-being of his
11 fellow man; and

12 WHEREAS, SPC Morgan gave the ultimate sacrifice for his country, and he embodied the
13 spirit of service, willing to find meaning in something greater than himself; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the sacrifices of this remarkable and
15 distinguished American be honored appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his memory.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
17 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge on State Route 38 over Woodyard Creek in
18 Clinch County is dedicated as the Jackie Marcell Morgan Memorial Bridge.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
20 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Jackie Marcell Morgan
21 Memorial Bridge.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
23 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
24 family of Jackie Marcell Morgan and to the Department of Transportation.
