A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Latino Community Fund Georgia; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Latino Community Fund Georgia has a long and consistent record of service
3 to the community and this state and has been recognized as one of the most dynamic and
4 committed civic organizations in Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, this outstanding organization has had a tremendous impact on its community
6 through its spirit of service and desire to improve the quality of life in the State of Georgia;

8 WHEREAS, this remarkable civic organization has established a glowing reputation of
9 renown throughout Georgia for its dedication and high ideals; and

10 WHEREAS, it has 41 member organizations, all Latinx led community groups, working
11 across the state to expand and create opportunities so communities can be healthier,
12 self-sufficient, and deeply engaged in participatory democracy; and

13 WHEREAS, it has raised and reinvested over \$13 million since 2017 supporting advocacy,
14 civic participation, health and well-being, and economic opportunity efforts; and

15 WHEREAS, its team is representative of the communities it serves, with individuals from
16 various backgrounds, experiences, belief systems, and nationalities; and

17 WHEREAS, its efforts have secured wins in the language and health access spaces at the
18 local and state level with legislative proposals; and

19 WHEREAS, it secured over 16,000 COVID vaccines during the pandemic with more than
20 30,000 people receiving public health education and prevention measures; and

21 WHEREAS, it has won several awards including Southeast Emmy honors for its public
22 engagement campaigns, centering on real experiences and people; and

23 WHEREAS, the Latino Community Fund Georgia has been dedicated to providing
24 unparalleled service and support and remains steadfastly committed to the principles of skill,
25 integrity, and responsibility; and

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
27 extraordinary organization be appropriately recognized.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
29 the members of this body recognize and commend the Latino Community Fund Georgia and
30 thank it for its efforts of behalf of the community and state.
