### A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and remembering the life of the Honorable Shaharyar A. Mughal; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Honorable Shaharyar A. Mughal was born on July 29, 1953, in Jacobabad,  
4 a distinguished native son of Sindh; and

5 WHEREAS, he attended University of Sindh and earned a Bachelor of Science (Honors)  
6 degree in Agriculture and Masters of Science (Honors) degree in Agriculture and Economics;  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, he earned a Masters of Law from United Kingdom and attended University of  
9 Queensland (Australia) to study Administration General; and

10 WHEREAS, the Honorable Shaharyar A. Mughal was selected by the United States  
11 Department of Treasury to attend Anti-Narcotics Training with the Federal Bureau of  
12 Investigations; and

13 WHEREAS, the Honorable Shaharyar A. Mughal began a long and distinguished career in  
14 public service in the 1980s upon being joining the Federal Investigation Agency (FIA) of  
15 Pakistan; and

16 WHEREAS, as the Deputy Director of the Federal Investigation Agency under the control  
17 of the Interior Secretary of Pakistan, the Honorable Shaharyar A. Mughal was responsible  
18 for border control, criminal investigation, and counterintelligence. He also undertook  
19 operations against terrorism, espionage, federal crimes, and smuggling as well as  
20 infringement and other specific crimes; and

21 WHEREAS, he had a particular passion for quality of education, international relations,  
22 foreign languages, geography, politics, and current affairs; and

23 WHEREAS, Georgia State Representative Farooq Mughal, son of the Honorable Shaharyar  
24 A. Mughal, became the first highest ranking Pakistan American elected official in the State  
25 of Georgia, fulfilling the dream of his father; and

26 WHEREAS, on February 11, 2017, Honorable Shaharyar A. Mughal passed peacefully in  
27 Karachi, Pakistan; loved by his beloved family, Yasmin Shaharyar, Farooq Bilal Mughal,  
28 Umer Talal Mughal, Birjis Fatima Mughal, Karam Hussain Mughal, Taimur Mughal, and  
29 Sulaiman Mughal; and

30 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of this monumental public service officer,  
31 distinguished Pakistani, and native son of Jacobabad, Sindh.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
33 the members of this body join together to express their deepest regret at the passing of the

34 Former Deputy Director of Federal Investigation Agency, the Honorable Shaharyar A.  
35 Mughal, and extend their most sincere condolences to his family and Georgia State  
36 Representative Farooq Mughal.
