- 3 with the passing of Denver Lee Rampey on April 2, 2012; and

- 7 for 40 years, including 31 years as general counsel for Southeastern Power Administration
- 8 in Elberton, Georgia; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Rampey received his undergraduate degree from Emory University and
- 10 attended the Walter F. George School of Law at Mercer University where he received his
- 11 juris doctorate in 1968; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he was a partner of Nunn, Geiger & Rampey in Warner Robins and Perry,
- 13 Georgia, and served as both the United States Attorney and Assistant United States Attorney
- 14 for the Middle District of Georgia; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Rampey was privileged to argue a legal case before the United States
- 16 Supreme Court in 1976; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
- 18 States Marine Corps from 1962-1965 as an artillery, embarkation, and intelligence officer,
- 19 valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans; and
