4 and has been recognized for her superlative achievement as an incredibly gifted student at  
5 Charles Drew High School; and

6 WHEREAS, Danielle has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal  
7 adroitness, and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

8 WHEREAS, she participated in dual enrollment for three semesters, taking on college level  
9 course work in addition to the normal high school curriculum while maintaining status as an  
10 honors student with a gifted certification; and

11 WHEREAS, Danielle has received numerous awards and accolades as a result of her  
12 academic prowess, including third place in Health Education at the Georgia HOSA State  
13 Leadership Conference, the Daughters of the American Revolution Good Citizen Award, and  
14 is the second African American Valedictorian in the history of Charles Drew High School,  
15 all while maintaining a 4.309 GPA; and

17 involvement by being a dedicated volunteer and by holding membership in several  
18 organizations and programs, including being president of Drew High School's National Beta  
19 Club and Healthcare Occupational Students of America (HOSA); and

21 important objective of the General Assembly, and Danielle has shown by academic  
22 accomplishment that the pursuit and attainment of scholastic success are within the reach of
