## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Charles Allen Nasworthy; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Charles Allen Nasworthy on February 8, 2016; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was born on February 26, 1987, in Augusta, Georgia, a beloved son of Lyn  
5 Nasworthy and Pam Carr; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he graduated from the University of Georgia with dual degrees in animal  
7 science and agricultural education, after which he completed his master's degree in  
8 agricultural leadership; and
- 9 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Allen was an active member of Union Grove  
10 United Methodist Church; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he taught at Locust Grove High School for two years, receiving the Teacher of  
12 the Year Award his first year of teaching, was a 4-H camp counselor for many years, and had  
13 been the director of Fortson 4-H Center since 2011; and
- 14 WHEREAS, during his tenure at Camp Fortson, Allen was instrumental in starting a petting  
15 zoo for children in the Atlanta area and was the BLS instructor, where he taught camp  
16 counselors lifeguarding and CPR; and
- 17 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Charles Allen Nasworthy will long be  
18 remembered for his love of family and friendship, and this loyal son and friend will be  
19 missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Charles Allen Nasworthy  
22 and express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
