A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Bishop Barbara Lewis King; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Bishop Barbara Lewis King, affectionately called Dr. Barbara, is the
- 3 Founder/Minister of the Hillside Chapel and Truth Center, Inc., in Atlanta, Georgia, and she
- 4 began this nondenominational, ecumenical ministry in 1971 with 12 members in her living
- 5 room and now has a growing congregation numbering more than 10,000; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a native of Houston, Texas, Dr. Barbara is a consecrated Bishop and Prelate,
- 7 whose ministry has extended throughout the world; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in 1963, she joined thousands at the March on Washington after Dr. King's, "I
- 9 Have a Dream" speech prompted her to commit fully to the cause of Civil Rights and the
- 10 necessity to promote change in the lives of all Americans; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in 2001, Dr. Barbara received the highest honor bestowed upon a woman in
- 12 Africa, and through elaborate ceremonies, rituals and prayers, she became the first female
- 13 to be enstooled as a Chief at Assin Nsuta, Ghana, West Africa; and
- 14 WHEREAS, her stool name is Nana Yaa Twumwaa I, and Nana means Chief, Yaa means
- 15 Thursday's child, a child with special spiritual power, special energy, and special courage;
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, Twumwaa is related to the name of Yaa Asantawaa, who is a spiritual sister of
- 18 Nana Yaa Twumwaa I and a national hero to the Ashanti people of Ghana; and
- 19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- 20 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
