1 Recognizing and commending Marvin S. Arrington, Jr., the District 5 Fulton County
2 Commissioner; and for other purposes.

4 District 5, which encompasses largely unincorporated Fulton County, East Point, East
5 Atlanta, and small parts of Union City and College Park; and
