- 1 Recognizing and commending Pastor Micheal Benton on his 40th pastoral anniversary and
- 2 congratulating him on his retirement in December, 2017; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Pastor Micheal Benton has demonstrated his commitment to teaching the
- 4 Gospel, witnessing Christ through word and deed, and addressing the physical,
- 5 psychological, intellectual, and spiritual needs of others; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Pastor Benton and his wife, Reverend Dr. Y'Vonne Benton, have led Fairfield
- 7 Baptist Church since 1977, and under their leadership the church has grown in membership,
- 8 service, focus, and spirituality; and
- 9 WHEREAS, an excellent expository preacher led by the Holy Spirit, Pastor Benton is often
- sought out by other preachers and pastors with requests to shepherd and mentor them; and
- 11 WHEREAS, this pastoral "elder statesman" founded the "Bread of Heaven Ministry," a
- 12 program that trains, teaches, and supports other pastors; and
- WHEREAS, Pastor Benton is a past president of "Right Choice," a collaboration of local
- 14 pastors and churches that partnered with high schools in their communities and supported,
- mentored, and provided after school activities for male students; and
- 16 WHEREAS, in 2012, Pastor Benton organized the "Community Thanksgiving Fellowship,"
- 17 providing an array of services to economically challenged members of the community,
- 18 including food boxes, clothing, shoes, school supplies, Bibles, toys, personal hygiene kits,
- 19 health screenings, and barber services, and in the five years of this program's existence,
- approximately 15 churches have come together to serve more than 2,000 people; and
- 21 WHEREAS, this master negotiator, skilled arbitrator, and compassionate mediator has
- 22 overseen the construction of several major projects on the church campus: two sanctuaries,

an administrative and educational center, a family life center, and the first church parking

- 25 WHEREAS, whether the task is preparing a sermon, visiting the sick, counseling the
- 26 troubled, baptizing a new believer, or acting as a theologian, educator, administrator, or
- 27 humanitarian, Pastor Benton serves as a shining example of God's righteous path; and

- 29 strength and direction for persons in all walks of life; and
- 30 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
- 31 of peace and love be recognized for his innumerable good works rendered on behalf of
- 32 persons in need.
