### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Cathelene "Tina" Robinson; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Cathelene "Tina" Robinson has long been recognized by the citizens of this  
3 state for the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment  
4 to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, on February 23, 2007, the Honorable Cathelene "Tina" Robinson was sworn  
6 into office as the Clerk of Superior Court of Fulton County, after the retirement of her  
7 predecessor Juanita Hicks; and

8 WHEREAS, the Clerk of Superior Court performs a wide range of duties, including record  
9 keeping, information management, and financial management functions in the judicial  
10 system; the office also provides personnel court support to each Superior Court judge; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Robinson also collaborates with other governmental and private agencies  
12 to help prevent crime, create ways to provide more efficient services to citizens, and  
13 implement ways to make Fulton County a safer place for all to live, work, and play; and

14 WHEREAS, prior to taking office, Ms. Robinson dedicated 30 years of service to the citizens  
15 of Fulton County; and

16 WHEREAS, she began working at the Health Department in 1974, the Tax Commissioner's  
17 Office in 1981, and the Fulton County Clerk of Superior Court Office in 1989; and

18 WHEREAS, throughout her career, she has maintained a strong commitment to community  
19 and customer service, not only in the criminal justice system, but also in the community at  
20 large; she has volunteered in numerous community initiatives and programs and has been  
21 recognized locally by a variety of civic organizations for her strong commitment to the  
22 community; and

23 WHEREAS, Ms. Robinson is the vice president of the George Washington Carver Alumni  
24 Association and serves as an advisory board member for the "Boys to Men" Youth Home and  
25 Sanctuary, a nonprofit organization for young boys; and

26 WHEREAS, a Georgia native, she credits her parents, the late James Russell Hearn, Sr., and  
27 Nellie Kimbro Hearn, as the driving force behind her commitment to community service; and

28 WHEREAS, Ms. Robinson is an active member of St. Peters Missionary Baptist Church and  
29 has been blessed with two remarkable daughters and one wonderful grandson; and

30 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
31 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
33 the members of this body recognize and commend Cathelene "Tina" Robinson for her  
34 efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated service to the State of Georgia and express to her  
35 their most sincere best wishes for continued success.
