- 2 WHEREAS, Shay Moorman was born on November 5, 1973, in Dublin, Georgia, to Veal  
3 and Elaine Moorman; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Shay was a graduate of Johnson County High School, the University of  
5 Georgia, where he majored in economics, and Florida State University, where he received  
6 both his J.D. and Masters of Law; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he worked as an attorney with Matthew Waters, Attorneys at Law; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Shay was a vital part of the Wrightsville community and served as the attorney  
9 for the Johnson County Commission; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was noted for partnering with his father and Johnson County Administrator,  
11 Guy Singletary, to renovate the Johnson County Courthouse clock; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Shay's life was tragically cut short on Saturday, February 22, 2014; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Shay is survived by his parents, Veal and Elaine Moorman of Wrightsville, his  
14 brother, Drew Moorman of Charlotte, North Carolina, and nephew, Elijah Moorman; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he  
17 made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Shay will long be remembered for his love  
19 of family and friendship, and this loyal gentleman and friend will be missed by all who had  
20 the great fortune of knowing him.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
22 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Shay Moorman and  
23 express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
