A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 8, 2017, as the 5th Annual Legislative Fly-In at the state capitol and
2 commending the Georgia Airports Association and its leadership; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Georgia's airport system is an extremely important and valuable transportation
4 resource for this state's residents, businesses, and visitors; and

5 WHEREAS, the mission of the Georgia Airports Association is "to provide, develop, and
6 expand a safe and efficient airports system to meet the future economic growth of Georgia
7 through the full implementation of the State Aviation System Plan"; and

8 WHEREAS, the State Aviation System Plan recognizes that airports are an indispensable
9 component of this state's total transportation system that strongly supports this state's
10 economy; and

11 WHEREAS, Georgia Airports Association President Jason Pinnix, past President Jim
12 Galloway, Vice President Kevin Britton, Treasurer Mike Mathews, Legislative Chair Mario
13 Evans, and Secretary Tom Strong have diligently and conscientiously worked to obtain the
