- 7 WHEREAS, this year's 26th annual Wild Game Supper will be held from 5-7:30 P.M. at the  
8 Georgia Railroad Depot on Tuesday, February 5, 2013; and

10 will dine on South Georgia quail, dove, venison, and wild hog; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Wild Game Supper is sponsored by the Georgia Southern University
