A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the University of Georgia School of Law on its National Moot
2 Court Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on February 10-13, 2014, the University of Georgia School of Law was
4 represented at the 64th Annual National Moot Court Competition by Mr. Steven L. Strasberg,
5 Mr. Benjamin W. Thorpe, and Ms. Emily K. Westberry; and

6 WHEREAS, the trio was undefeated in the national tier of the tournament held in New York
7 City, New York, and Mr. Thorpe was named the competition's best oralist; and

8 WHEREAS, the trio had victories over Emory University School of Law, Case Western
9 Reserve University School of Law, Chicago-Kent College of Law, Drake University Law
10 School, Hofstra University School of Law, and Seattle University Law School; and

11 WHEREAS, the National Moot Court Competition is the oldest and one of the most
12 prestigious moot court competitions in the country; and

13 WHEREAS, more than 190 teams from law schools across the nation competed in this year's
14 contest; and

15 WHEREAS, this is the first time that the University of Georgia School of Law has won this
16 tournament since 1997; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this national championship by the
18 University of Georgia School of Law Moot Court team be celebrated.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body recognize and commend Mr. Steven L. Strasberg, Mr. Benjamin

21 W. Thorpe, Ms. Emily K. Westberry, Georgia Law Director of Advocacy Ms. Kellie Casey,
22 School of Law Dean Rebecca H. White, and the University of Georgia School of Law Moot
23 Court team for its achievement and accomplishments.
