## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending members of the Region 7 Emergency Medical Services  
2 Section; and for other purposes.

4 re-license, and monitor ambulance services, medical first responders, and neonatal transport  
5 services; to approve training course curriculum and requirements for the licensure and  
6 re-licensure of technicians and paramedics; and for the re-licensing only of emergency
