## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending the Olivia Haydel Senior Center; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Olivia Haydel Senior Center serves residents of Rockdale County that are  
3 aged 60 and over; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the aging program began more than 30 years ago by its founder, Olivia Haydel,  
5 providing congregate meals, meals-on-wheels, case management, transportation, information  
6 and referral, kinship care, caregivers, social and athletic activities, volunteers, homemakers,  
7 and respite services; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the senior program in Rockdale County is operated by the county and is proud  
9 to work hand-in-hand with the Atlanta Regional Commission; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the senior program boasts more than 700 center members and served more than  
11 4,000 seniors last year; and
- 12 WHEREAS, as the demand for services continues to expand with the increase of "baby  
13 boomers" in the Rockdale area, the senior center is seeking additional funding opportunities  
14 and creative ways to serve those in need; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
16 remarkable organization be appropriately recognized.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
18 the members of this body recognize and commend the Olivia Haydel Senior Center for  
19 serving this state's aging population and express their most sincere best wishes for the  
20 organization's continued success.
