- school, which won first place in the Georgia State Competition four years in a row; and
- 13 WHEREAS, during his senior year, they performed at the FFA National Convention in
- 14 Kansas City in front of an audience of 100,000; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Ritchie served as a firefighter from the mid-1980s to the mid-1990s in
- 16 Gwinnett County, owned a computer store, worked for Fannin County Schools, worked for
- 17 ETC, and was a member of the board of directors at Tri-State EMC; and
- 18 WHEREAS, those who knew Mr. Ritchie described him as a gentleman and a great musician,
- 19 with a witty sense of humor that will sorely be missed but never forgotten; and
