A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mauricio Guadamuz; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mauricio Guadamuz has been selected to receive the 2013 Virtuoso Award by
3 Mexican American Engineers and Scientists (MAES) and is the recipient of the 2013 Rising
4 Star Award from the National Association of Latinos in Information and Sciences and
5 Technology (LISTA); and

6 WHEREAS, the Virtuoso Award is the top national award for scientists and engineers given
7 by MAES and recognizes individuals showing exemplary capabilities in management and
8 leadership; technology advancement in the areas of procurement, research and development;
9 or leadership in increasing diversity among the technical disciplines; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Guadamuz is currently pursuing his Ph.D. in the School of Aerospace
11 Engineering at the Georgia Institute of Technology and is also employed as a staff systems
12 engineer for Lockheed Martin Corporation; and

13 WHEREAS, he received a master's degree from the Georgia Institute of Technology in 2000
14 and his bachelor's degree from the University of Florida in 1999; and

15 WHEREAS, at Lockheed Martin, Mr. Guadamuz has reported to the vice president for
16 Technology for Corporate Engineering and Technology since August, 2011, and in
17 December of 2010, he was accepted in the Chief Technology Officer's Corporate
18 Engineering and Technology Ph.D. Program; and

19 WHEREAS, prior to his educational leave from Lockheed Martin, he served as Campus
20 Relations Manager for University Talent Acquisition, where he led efforts to increase the
21 footprint and impact of college minority hires and research collaboration with key
22 universities for Lockheed Martin; and

23 WHEREAS, Mr. Guadamuz is a recognized community figure in Atlanta where he has
24 served as the Atlanta chapter president for LISTA; and

25 WHEREAS, he was nominated in 2011 to receive the HENACC Santiago-Rodriguez
26 Diversity Award, a landmark, national nomination for those that have made significant
27 strides in driving diversity at major corporations; and

28 WHEREAS, Mr. Guadamuz was also nominated in 2007 to receive the HENAAC Most
29 Promising Engineer or Scientist with Advanced Degree Award, a top nomination in the
30 United States for Hispanic individuals that have made significant engineering and science
31 contributions; and

32 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
33 remarkable Georgian be appropriately recognized.

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
35 the members of this body recognize and commend Mauricio Guadamuz for his countless
36 awards and recognitions and express to him their most sincere best wishes for continued
37 success.
