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House Resolution 255

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Environmental Justice; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, environmental hazards pose a serious risk to the health and welfare of the
- 3 citizens of this state; and
- 4 WHEREAS, certain facilities that require permitting from regulatory bodies, including from
- 5 the Environmental Protection Division of the Department of Natural Resources, may be
- 6 sources of pollution that are creating, or could potentially create, environmental hazards in
- 7 the state; and
- 8 WHEREAS, such facilities that are sources of pollution, through the decision to place such
- 9 facilities in certain areas over others as well as potential uneven enforcement of
- 10 environmental laws and regulations, may be disproportionally impacting low-income
- 11 neighborhoods or neighborhoods populated by minorities in the state; and
- 12 WHEREAS, equal enforcement of environmental laws and regulations as well as ensuring
- 13 that the impact on low-income and minority neighborhoods is fully considered in permitting
- 14 decisions would mitigate or alleviate the disproportionate effect such facilities may have on
- 15 low-income and minority residents of the state; and

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16 WHEREAS, study is needed to develop potential legislation or other action that could be

- 17 taken to ensure that low-income and minority residents of the state are not disproportionally
- 18 impacted by sources of pollution from certain facilities that are creating, or have the potential
- 19 to create, environmental hazards in the state.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- 21 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
- on Environmental Justice.
- 23 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
- House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 25 Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson
- of the committee.
- 27 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 30 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 32 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 34 (5) **Allowances and funding.** The legislative members of the committee shall receive
- 35 the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia
- Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any
- 37 member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.

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- 40 (6) **Report.**
- 41 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- 47 of this paragraph.
- 48 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- 51 the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- 52 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
- House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
- 54 thereof.
- 55 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2023.
