- 16 illustrious chapter of Georgia history and will be showcased in schools in order to help foster
- and nurture a more enlightened student group, thereby helping to prepare them to compete
- and succeed as global citizens in an ever-increasing multicultural society, by having a
- 19 broader awareness of the immediate world in which they live and an understanding of the
- 20 value of full citizen participation in the cultural heritage that defines a community and a
- 21 nation; and
- 22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper to recognize Eleanor for her vision and
- 23 unyielding commitment to showcasing the historical narrative of many of the unknown
- 24 places and events that punctuate African American history in Georgia.
