A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus was established to promote diversity
3 and inclusiveness for IBEW minority members at all levels of the IBEW structure; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus has promoted and encouraged IBEW
5 minority members to become activists in community and political affairs; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Electrical Workers Minority Caucus members are actively involved in
7 AFL-CIO constituency groups, human, civil, and women's rights organizations to advance
8 the cause of minority workers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus fosters leadership development and
10 empowers IBEW minority members to become activists and leaders in organized labor; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus has, in the last 25 years, performed
12 over 850,000 hours of community service across the United States with an additional 2,000
13 hours of community service on 32 projects throughout metropolitan Atlanta planned during
14 January of this year; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus has a longstanding tradition of
16 advocating for working families and worker rights; and
- 17 WHEREAS, organized labor and workers throughout North America would be less
18 successful without the contributions of the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus and its
19 chapters and members spanning both the United States and Canada.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus is commended for its contributions to Georgia and
22 the nation.
