- 15 former colleague and senator, Ronald Ramsey, who is a sitting judge in the State Court of

- 17 experiences as an educator, legislator and jurist, and will inspire the youth to consider the
- 18 limitless possibilities available for legal and public service; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the Youth Law Camp, in addition to providing educational benefits, empowers
- 20 the students to become good citizens through its teen choices and consequences session and
- 21 interactive mock trial and newly-added mock legislation activities; and
- 22 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives recognize the significant vision, leadership and
- organizational skills and sensitivity to the needs of our youth and legal community that Judge
- 24 Aten possesses to spearhead the Youth Law Camp and host the program on annual basis; and
