A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Georgia Youth Science & Technology Centers (GYSTC) as well as
2 the 2023 Don Cargill STEM Scholars for their innovative and integrated teaching of science,
3 technology, engineering, and mathematics in kindergarten through eighth grade classrooms;

17 to broaden the pipeline of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics majors for
18 Georgia's workforce.

20 the members of this body commend the Georgia Youth Science & Technology Centers
21 (GYSTC) for their work, dedication, and devoted service to all teachers of Georgia and
22 especially the 2023 Don Cargill STEM Scholars who demonstrate innovation and hard work
23 in their classrooms.
