## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Gwendolyn Cherry Marks; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Mrs. Gwendolyn Cherry Marks on June 19, 2012; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Marks was born in Monticello, Georgia, on September 17, 1933, the  
5 beloved daughter of Thomas and Eliza Jordan Cherry and was a long-time member of St.  
6 James A.M.E. Church; and
- 7 WHEREAS, she was raised by her grandparents, Charlie and Nannie Lee Jordan, and her  
8 father and stepmother, Inez Cherry, and educated in the Jasper County Public School System;

- 10 WHEREAS, a graduate of Mathers School for Women in South Carolina, Mrs. Marks  
11 attended Fort Valley State College Nursing Program and dedicated 24 years to Georgia  
12 Pacific, where she was affectionately known as "Grandma"; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Marks was united in love and marriage to the late Willie James Marks and  
14 was blessed with the love and support of her remarkable children, Jacqueline Smith, Ethel  
15 Jones, Loraine and Lucius Pitts, Margaret Gilmore, Enrickie and Christina Jackson, Willie  
16 Mae Barkley, Rosemary Tinsley, Betty and Larry Thurman, Larry Marks, and Joanne Ellis;

- 18 WHEREAS, in addition to her children and stepmother, she leaves behind many who will  
19 cherish her memory, including Joe Ridley, Doris Moore, Beverly Thomas, Wilhelmina
