A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the City of Avondale Estates for its Tree City USA recognition; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, located in DeKalb County near Decatur, Avondale Estates was founded in 1924
- 4 by George Francis Willis, a patent medicine magnate; and
- 5 WHEREAS, originally named Ingleside, the village was purchased by Willis to create a
- 6 planned community; he named it for the birthplace of William Shakespeare,
- 7 Stratford-upon-Avon, and its Tudor-style buildings reinforce this English pride; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the city was incorporated in 1927, noted as being the only planned city in the
- 9 Southeast; today, it boasts a population of 2,960 and is listed in the National Register of
- 10 Historic Places; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Avondale Estates was named by the Arbor Day Foundation as a 2018 Tree City
- 12 in honor of its commitment to effective urban forest management; and
- WHEREAS, the city achieved Tree City USA recognition by meeting the program's four
- 14 requirements: a tree board or department, a tree-care ordinance, an annual community
- 15 forestry budget of at least \$2.00 per capita, and an Arbor Day observance and proclamation;
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, the city also received a Tree City USA Growth Award for demonstrating
- 18 environmental improvement and higher level of tree care; and
- 19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- 20 extraordinary city be appropriately recognized.
