A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Rural Medical Personnel Recruitment; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, rural hospitals face many challenges in delivering services to patients living and
- 4 working in the coverage area; and
- 5 WHEREAS, rural hospitals seek to provide surgical and procedural services despite
- 6 economic challenges and a lack of availability of healthcare professionals; and
- 7 WHEREAS, surgical and procedural treatment often require support services in anesthesia,
- 8 technology, and postoperative care; and
- 9 WHEREAS, rural hospital executives are challenged to recruit surgical personnel; and
- 10 WHEREAS, a study is needed to raise awareness of the challenges of rural hospitals to
- 11 recruit surgical personnel and to hire and retain surgical support personnel.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

(1) Creation of House study committee. There is created the House Study Committee
 on Rural Medical Personnel Recruitment.

- 15 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
- House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 17 Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson
- of the committee.
- 19 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- 20 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- 21 legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 22 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- 23 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution. No fewer than two meetings
- shall be conducted in a county with a rural hospital organization, as such term is defined
- in Code Section 31-8-9.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- 28 (5) **Allowances and funding.** The legislative members of the committee shall receive
- the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia
- Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any
- 31 member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.
- 34 (6) **Report.**
- 35 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- 38 subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.

39 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for 40 proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report subject to subparagraph (C) 41 of this paragraph.

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- (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee. A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- 46 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
 47 House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
 48 thereof.
- 49 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2023.
