## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Celebrating the 40th anniversary of the magistrate court system; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, established in 1983 by the Constitution of the State of Georgia, the magistrate
- 3 court system signaled a major change to the court system that consisted of some parts which
- 4 had existed since colonial times; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in order to provide for a more unified court system, the 1983 Constitution
- 6 provided for uniform jurisdiction, rules of practice, and procedure for the magistrate courts,
- 7 replacing numerous courts that had differing civil and criminal jurisdictions and practices;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, the legislation replaced the Justices of the Peace courts that were in the 1976
- 10 Constitution; in the 1983 Constitution, Article VI, Section I, Paragraph I vests certain judicial
- power to the magistrate courts and Article VI, Section I, Paragraph VI provides that each
- 12 county shall have at least one magistrate court; and
- 13 WHEREAS, for 40 years, the magistrate courts have provided Georgia citizens with
- 14 cost-effective access to the civil justice system in all 159 counties in Georgia and have
- 15 played a crucial role in the criminal justice system, determining whether or not arrest

16 warrants and search warrants should be issued, setting bonds, holding probable cause

- 17 hearings, and trying certain misdemeanor offenses; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that such an important aspect of Georgia's
- 19 justice system be appropriately recognized.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 21 the members of this body celebrate the 40th anniversary of the magistrate court system.
- 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 23 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to
- 24 Brandon T. Bryson, chief magistrate judge of Bartow County, Georgia.
