## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 23, 2023, as GoVoteGA Day at the Capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, in the past decade, GoVoteGA partners have dedicated innumerable hours of  
3 their time and energy toward voter engagement, outreach, and empowerment; and
- 4 WHEREAS, their exemplary efforts have resulted in the registration of 33,293 recently  
5 naturalized new Americans, the prevention of the disenfranchisement of thousands of rural  
6 BIPOC voters, the statewide surveying of the needs, interests, and policy priorities of women  
7 of color, and much more; and
- 8 WHEREAS, since 2014, this outstanding organization has increased phone outreach by 354  
9 percent, text outreach by 1,100 percent, mail outreach by 4,053 percent, and doors outreach  
10 by 138 percent; and
- 11 WHEREAS, GoVoteGA continues to work to address the security and safety of people in  
12 this state and its systems, develop organizational benchmarks and metrics, scale up civic  
13 engagement, and expand its mission and reach; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this magnificent organization be  
15 appropriately honored.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
17 the members of this body recognize March 23, 2023, as GoVoteGA Day at the Capitol.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
19 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
20 public and the press.
