A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing January 28, 2019, as Effingham County Day at the capitol, and saluting the
2 Effingham County Chamber of Commerce; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, for a number of years, Effingham County has sponsored Effingham County Day
4 at the Georgia State Capitol by sending a delegation to visit with and entertain members of
5 the General Assembly and others there; and

6 WHEREAS, Effingham County borders on the Savannah River, includes three incorporated
7 municipalities – Rincon, Springfield, and Guyton – has several smaller communities
8 including Meldrim, Faulkville, Pineora, Stillwell, Egypt, Cloy, Ebenezer, and Shawnee, and
9 is widely recognized for its outstanding quality of life; and

10 WHEREAS, Effingham County Day will be observed again on January 28, 2019, under the
11 sponsorship of the Effingham County Chamber of Commerce and its president, Brian
12 Dickey; and

13 WHEREAS, the Effingham County Chamber of Commerce was founded in 1986 to support
14 existing businesses, and to attract new firms to the thriving business climate in the county;

16 WHEREAS, the chamber today boasts more than 300 members from a wide variety of
17 businesses, and contributes greatly to the community and the State of Georgia through its
18 work of "Bringing People and Opportunities Together."

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 this body does hereby recognize January 28, 2019, as Effingham County Day at the capitol,
21 and extends to the Effingham County Chamber of Commerce its commendation for the
22 chamber's many important contributions to the Effingham County community and the State
23 of Georgia.
