A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Christian City on the occasion of its 50th anniversary; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the first cottage at Christian City's Home For Children was opened to eight boys
4 on February 14, 1965; and

5 WHEREAS, the 500 acre campus is located in Union City, Georgia, and offers services for
6 seniors and a residential home for children; and

7 WHEREAS, facilities for seniors represent the second largest active retirement community
8 in the metro Atlanta area and includes the largest assisted living facility and a five-star
9 nursing and rehabilitation center, recognized in *US News & World Report* as one of the best
10 in the nation; and

11 WHEREAS, the Children's Village offers life services and a safe haven for children in crisis,
12 aged 5-17; the majority who come to the program are victims of abuse, neglect, or
13 abandonment; and

14 WHEREAS, Christian City provides a welcoming home environment and all that is required
15 for success including nutritious meals; psychological, medical, and dental attention; clothing;
16 and a quality education; and

17 WHEREAS, the devotion, patience, and understanding this organization has demonstrated
18 have provided the foundation and framework of success in which members of the community
19 have developed and flourished; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this organization be recognized and
21 commended for its dedication and commitment to helping others.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
23 the members of this body recognize and commend Christian City on the grand occasion of
24 its 50th anniversary for its contributions to the State of Georgia.
