- 22 is responsible for several Atlanta and non-Atlanta campuses, handling emergencies ranging
- 23 from elevator entrapment to building evacuations to active shooters, and she is also

- 25 composes public service announcements for different emergencies and also provides training
- 26 exercises to ensure all safety specialists have knowledge on Occupant Emergency Plans; and

- 28 leadership appears effortless, and she is known for always finding a creative solution to
- 29 problems, no matter how big or small, and her talent has let her progress professionally over
