## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Ceek to Fulfill; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, founded in the pivotal years between 2006 and 2009 by the compassionate duo
Charles and Evelyn Cooksey, Ceek to Fulfill has emerged as a beacon of hope in the
landscape of non-profit organizations dedicated to aiding youth aging out of the foster care

7 250,000 children annually; however, as these young individuals reach the age of 18, a

WHEREAS, recognizing the broader spectrum of needs, the organization evolved in 2009 to emphasize workforce development, GED preparation classes, and assistance in high school diploma completion. This strategic shift was not just about offering immediate aid; it was about empowering these young individuals with the tools and skills needed for long-term success and independence; and

WHEREAS, the impact of this transition has been nothing short of remarkable. With an 80
percent success rate, Ceek to Fulfill has assisted more than 500 youth, not only in crossing
the threshold of education but also in stepping confidently into a future they can shape; and

WHEREAS, the organization's efforts in financial literacy further equip these young adults with the knowledge to manage their finances effectively, a critical skill that lays the foundation for a stable and prosperous life; and

WHEREAS, although it closed its doors in 2023, Ceek to Fulfill stands as a testament to what dedicated, compassionate support can achieve. In a world where many young adults aging out of foster care face uncertain futures, this organization shines as a pillar of hope and a catalyst for change. The legacy of Charles and Evelyn Cooksey, and the continued dedication of the Ceek to Fulfill team will undoubtedly echo for generations as they continue to transform lives and build brighter futures.
