## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Exchange Club of Rome and its Americanism Committee for the
- 2 community service project they sponsored to commemorate the 200th anniversary of the
- 3 Star-Spangled Banner; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the United States celebrated the 200th anniversary of the *Star-Spangled Banner*
- 5 on September 14, 2014; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the purpose of the Exchange Club of Rome's Americanism Committee program
- 7 was to promote American heritage and patriotism in the Rome community and throughout
- 8 the Greater Rome area; and
- 9 WHEREAS, on the 200th anniversary of the United States national anthem, the Exchange
- 10 Club of Rome gave the citizens of Rome and Floyd County a replica of the American flag
- 11 that inspired the patriotic lyrics of the Star-Spangled Banner; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the club also gave the citizens of Rome and Floyd County a current 50 star flag,
- and both flags fly over the City of Rome during the day and are properly illuminated during
- 14 the night as an example of respect for the symbol of the United States and of proper flag
- 15 etiquette; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Jackson Hill, one of the Seven Hills of Rome, was chosen as the site for flying
- 17 the replica of the original flag that inspired Francis Scott Key to write the heartfelt and
- patriotic lyrics of the national anthem 200 years ago while he was experiencing the attack on
- 19 Fort McHenry by the British army; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the flag and his lyrics helped the American people establish their resolve,
- 21 overcome economic fear of losing valuable ports on the eastern shores, and establish
- 22 America as a truly sovereign nation among the nations of the world; and

WHEREAS, community leaders, the Exchange Club of Rome, and the youth of this great

- 24 community came together on the 200th anniversary of the national anthem to affirm that
- 25 America is truly a noble nation bound together through heritage and patriotism; and
- 26 WHEREAS, the Exchange Club of Rome has continuously served the Rome and Floyd
- 27 County community for 78 years; and
- 28 WHEREAS, the Americanism Committee of the Exchange Club of Rome is committed to
- 29 promoting pride in this county, this state, and this nation; respect for the flag; appreciation
- 30 of freedom; and passing American heritage from one generation to the next through a variety
- 31 of programs; and
- 32 WHEREAS, the program "Give a Kid a Flag to Wave" presents small American flags to
- 33 fourth grade children and teaches them respect for the flag and proper flag etiquette in the
- 34 school as well as in the community; and
- 35 WHEREAS, "Proudly We Hail" nominates, recognizes, and awards residents, businesses,
- 36 schools, and government agencies in a competitive program for properly displaying the
- 37 American flag; and
- 38 WHEREAS, the Exchange Club of Rome has presented Freedom Shrines to schools, the
- 39 Forum, and the Floyd County Courthouse.
- 40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 41 the members of this body commend the Exchange Club of Rome and its Americanism
- 42 Committee for the community service project they sponsored to commemorate the 200th
- 43 anniversary of the Star-Spangled Banner.
- 44 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 46 Exchange Club of Rome.
