## A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating and commending Renee Cail for receiving the 2022 Yellow Rose Nikki T.  
2 Randall Servant Leader Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in 1999, Representative Nikki T. Randall became the first African American  
4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of  
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia  
6 Legislative Women's Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Legislative Women's  
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and  
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Renee Cail has been a champion for environmental justice as the president of  
11 Citizens for a Healthy and Safe Environment, advocating for people to attain their highest  
12 quality of life through clean air, water, and soil; and

13 WHEREAS, she has assisted communities in battling corporations with a history of spewing  
14 toxic emissions that harm the residents of predominantly African American, rural, and  
15 disenfranchised communities; and

16 WHEREAS, dedicated to bettering disenfranchised communities, Renee has been a key part  
17 in facilitating litigation on behalf of her fellow citizens and educating the community about  
18 hazardous chemicals and climate change; and

19 WHEREAS, she has established a glowing reputation of renown throughout Georgia for her  
20 efforts to improve the lives of children; her deep personal commitment to the welfare of the  
21 citizens of Georgia; and her energy, devotion, and commitment to environmental justice; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
23 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
25 the members of this body congratulate and commend Renee Cail for receiving the 2022  
26 Yellow Rose Nikki T. Randall Servant Leader Award and extend best wishes for her  
27 continued success.
