A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 31, 2015, as César E. Chávez Day at the state capitol and honoring Mr.
- 2 Chavez's birthday; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Mr. César E. Chávez, born in 1927, rose from humble beginnings to become
- 4 the founder of the United Farm Workers, making him a major force in American history and
- 5 a heroic figure of the 20th century; and
- 6 WHEREAS, through personal sacrifice, Mr. Chávez focused national attention on the plight
- 7 of farm workers, making the world aware of the necessity for safe and fair working
- 8 conditions in the fields of the United States; and
- 9 WHEREAS, millions of Americans of all races and nationalities from across the nation
- 10 joined him in the movement for farm workers' rights; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Mr. Chávez was a champion for civil rights, labor rights, voting rights, and
- women's rights and was an early environmentalist who warned the public of the devastating
- 13 effects of pesticides on both farm workers and consumers; and
- 14 WHEREAS, as a result of these and other valuable contributions, nine states now celebrate
- 15 César E. Chávez's birthday, March 31, as a holiday, including California, Arizona, Texas,
- 16 New Mexico, Colorado, Utah, Michigan, Illinois, and Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS, countless schools, streets, libraries, and other public institutions have been
- 18 named after César E. Chávez, and many cities have honored him by establishing an official
- 19 city holiday on his birthday; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the life of Mr. Chávez, who, like Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., was an adherent
- 21 of nonviolent civil disobedience, serves as a model for all Americans; and

22 WHEREAS, the César E. Chávez National Holiday organization, based in Los Angeles,

- 23 California, is spearheading a national effort to win support for a national holiday and day of
- service, learning, and action to be established on his birthday, March 31; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the Georgia Latino Forum unanimously passed a similar resolution supporting
- 26 the César E. Chávez National Holiday effort at its second annual meeting on
- 27 January 26, 2008, as did the Council of Columbus, Georgia, on October 7, 2008; and
- 28 WHEREAS, the Georgia Association of Latino Elected Officials (GALEO), the GALEO
- 29 Latino Community Development Fund, and the GALEO Leadership Council held a historic,
- 30 multiracial, and multiethnic rally in support of the César E. Chávez National Holiday effort
- in 2009 at the state capitol, the second annual event held in Georgia to honor César E.
- 32 Chávez.
- 33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 34 the members of this body recognize March 31, 2015, as César E. Chávez Day at the state
- 35 capitol in honor of his birthday and exemplary work on behalf of farm workers, civil rights,
- 36 labor rights, and women's rights.
- 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 38 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 39 César E. Chávez National Holiday organization.
